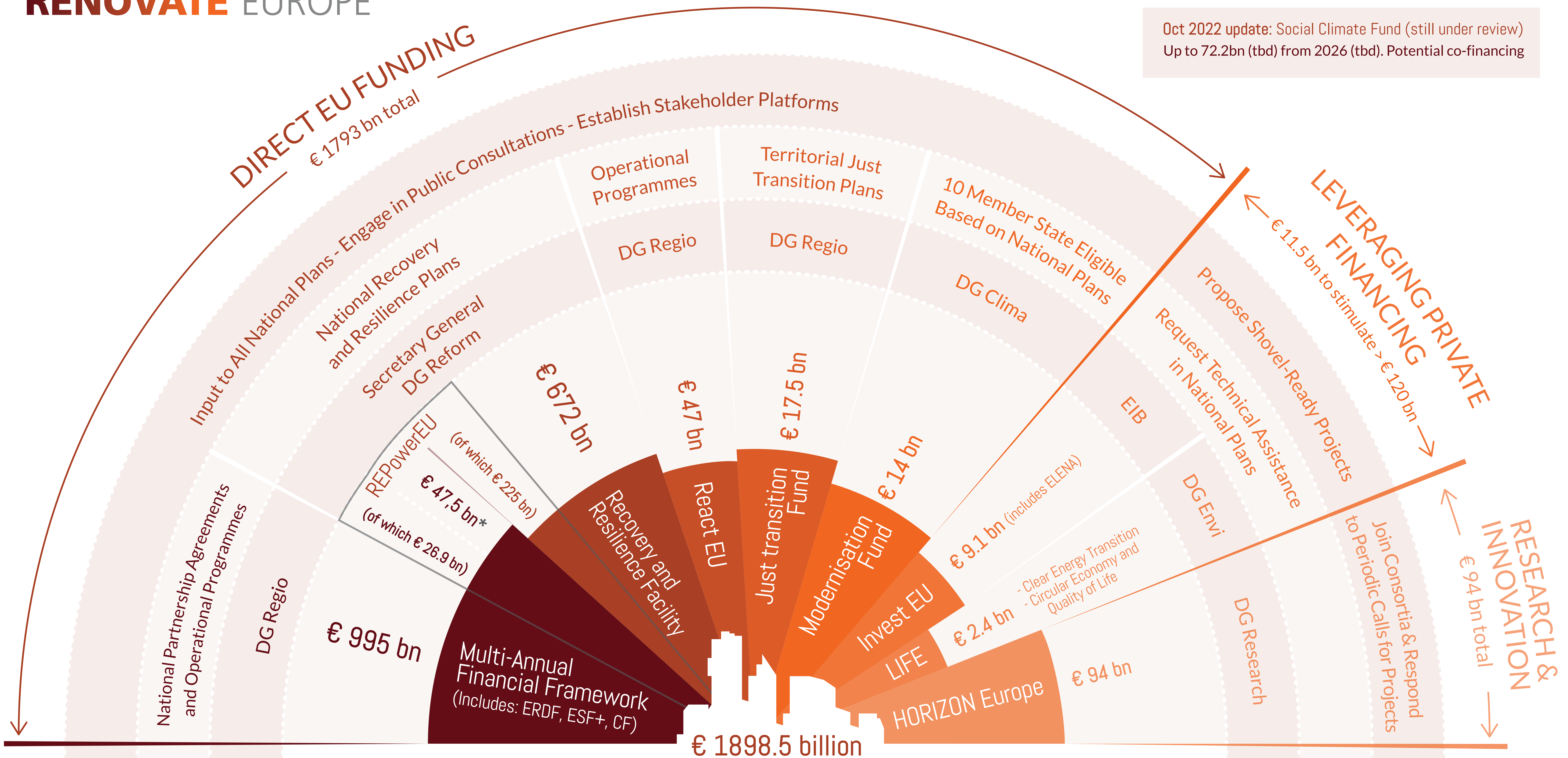


Oct 2022 update: Social Climate Fund (still under review)
